#### **Sample Itinerary:**

Day 1: Travel day to Washington D.C. Accommodations: Courtyard by Marriott—Downtown.

Day 2: Our local guide joins us all day for a sightseeing tour. See the Monuments & Memorials by day. We will actually get upclose to the Lincoln and Vietnam Memorial. Additional Highlights: Holocaust Museum—This is a difficult ticket to obtain especially during the spring. Please note this is subject to availability. Arlington National Cemetery— Outdoor tram tour including a stop at John F Kennedy Gravesite. Dinner is included at a fine local restaurant overlooking the Potomac River. This evening enjoy a Monuments & Memorials— "Evening Illumination Tour".

**Day 3:** Visit **George Washington's Mount Vernon.** A guided tour of the mansion is followed by time to explore the museums, Historic Area & Outbuildings. A delightful sit down **lunch is included** at **Mount Vernon Inn**. Head to Williamsburg for our next (2) nights with lodging at **4-star Williamsburg Lodge.** Located in the heart of the historic district, the hotel blends the elegance of a Virginia estate with modern amenities. **Dinner is included** at our hotel. Evening **Illumination Tour.** 

Day 4: A one-hour guided walking tour gets us acquainted with Colonial Williamsburg. After, spend the entire day exploring one of the country's best-preserved colonial sites. Williamsburg was the scene of Patrick Henry's Resolutions against the Stamp Act: the May 15, 1776 Resolution for Independence: George Mason's Virginia Declaration of Rights: The Virginia Constitution which served as a model for the constitutions of many other states: and Thomas Jefferson's bill for establishing religious freedom. In 1926, while a significant number of the famous landmarks still remained, steps were taken to restore and preserve the historic town. Now, after fifty years, Williamsburg is internationally known as a twentieth-century adventure in restoration and education. Centered on mile-long Duke of Gloucester Street, the city's Historic Area encompasses 173 acres. Stately homes, public buildings, busy craft shops, and peaceful gardens and greens rekindle a sense of the American heritage for a million visitors annually. Dinner included at one of the famous taverns in Williams including a "National Builder" first person portrayal of Thomas Jefferson.

**Day 5:** Visit and tour **Monticello**, home of **Thomas Jefferson**. Our visit features the Exhibits at the Visitor Center, the Highlights Tour of the Mansion, Jefferson's Gravesite, and the Slavery Tour. **Lunch is included** at **Michie Tavern**, the historic 1784 landmark. Overnight in Staunton, VA.

**Day 6:** Enroute home tour the **Beckley Coal Mine** as we ride aboard trams through a vintage coal mine. The guides are veteran miners and provide firsthand accounts of past and present day miners.
