Sample Itinerary:

Day 1 - One of North America's most spectacular fall color destinations is not far from home. Our trip takes us into Northern Ontario, Canada and Northern Michigan to experience some of the most brilliant fall colors in North America. Travel to Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, home of the Soo Locks and the beautiful St. Mary's River. Aboard the Soo Locks Cruise, we'll cruise down the shipping channel along the shorelines of Michigan and Ontario. Cruise through the Soo Locks and enjoy a sailors view of this landmark attraction. After an included dinner, we'll check into the Water Tower Inn Hotel in Sault Ste. Marie, Canada.

Day 2 - The Canadian wilderness is ablaze with color during autumn and for decades the **Agawa Canyon Railway** has been a favorite journey to experience some of the most spectacular fall colors in North America. Through large windows the beauty of the region will unfold and you will experience the rugged landscape of **Agawa Canyon Country**. Just when you thought you'd experienced it all, the train will begin its descent into the canyon at Mile 102 and as the rail line hugs the top of the canyon wall you will travel down 500 feet over the next 10 miles to the floor of the Agawa Canyon, created over 1.2 billion years ago by faulting and widened and reshaped by the last ice-age that retreated 10,000 years ago. As the train pulls to a stop at Mile 114, you'll have 1.5 hours to experience the pristine beauty of Canyon Park up close on the floor of the stunning canyon. Enjoy a box lunch in the beauty of the landscape surrounding us.

Day 3 - Cross back into Northern Michigan which is recognized along with Vermont and New Hampshire among America's top fall color destinations. Travel through the Tunnel of Trees, ranked among the most scenic fall color drives in the U.S. Next, visit and tour Castle Farms, a beautiful French Renaissance castle built in 1918. Soaring towers, stone buildings, sweeping gardens and Michigan's largest Outdoor Model Railroad are featured on this guided tour. Lunch is included. Later enjoy a brief tour of Charlevoix and see the "Mushroom Houses", some of the most unusual homes in the America! Overnight in lovely Petoskey, Michigan, a charming and up-scale community. Dinner included.

Day 4 - View some of the brilliant Michigan fall scenery on a **back road tour** and also a **tour of Petoskey**. Tour **Kilwin's Chocolates Factory**, a Michigan landmark since 1947. Late morning enjoy some leisure time in downtown Petoskey with over 170 unique shops, galleries, boutiques, pubs and restaurants in their famous Gaslight District. Early to mid afternoon head for home with mid evening arrival back home.
