**Sample Itinerary:**

**Day 1:** Travel to Utica, NY for our first night.

**Day 2:** Board **The Adirondack Scenic Railroad** for our memorable autumn journey through the **Adirondack Mountains**. Travel through forests, over rivers and streams and enjoy the dazzling fall colors through the mountains. Arrive in **Lake Placid, NY** for **(3) nights** at the **Grand Adirondack Hotel, a Marriott Tribute Portfolio Hotel**. Located in the heart of downtown Lake Placid, it's the perfect location for our (3) nights stay. **Dinner included.**

**Day 3:** Visit **High Falls Gorge**, a 22-acre, privately owned nature park. Since the 1890's, the "powers that be" have provided safe trail access for all ages to an otherwise inaccessible narrow granite walled gorge with (4) spectacular waterfalls. Flat paths, handrails, fencing, and seating areas make it safe and accessible for older guests. We will also tour the **Olympic jumping facility** today. Ski jumping showcases, competitions, and athlete training is at the core of the Olympic Jumping Complex. there is the newly-remodeled scenic elevator that takes you to the sky deck of the **128 meter ski jump**. With its glass exterior, the ride-up gives a stunning bird's-eye view of the Adirondack High Peaks. At the top, the sky deck offers **360-degree panoramic views of Lake Placid**— the kind that would usually require an hour-long hike up a mountain—all accessible in just a 30-second elevator ride. **Dinner included.**

**Day 5:** Board the Ferry to cross beautiful **Lake Champlain into Vermont**. Board the **Spirit of Ethan Allen Lunch Cruise** for a scenic lake cruise with lunch included. After the cruise, take the ferry back and continue into **Canada** as we highlight the lovely **1,000 Islands**. Stay **(2) nights** in **Kingston, Ontario, home of the 1,000 Islands**.

**Day 6:** Late morning all aboard the **1,000 Island Cruise** as we explore the scenery that has made the region famous throughout the world. Ee the famed **Boldt Castle** and **Lavish homes** along "**Millionaire's Row**".
