Sample Itinerary:

DAY 1 - With September being the best month of the year to travel, we'll set out on a first class vacation to beautiful **Cape Cod**. The families will be long gone, the weather is mild and the ocean is still warm from summer temperatures. Overnight in Pennsylvania.
