PHYSICAL ABILITIES FOR TRAVEL:

- Standing & Walking – able to for 15-30 minutes without accommodation.
- Airports/Transfers – may require a lengthy walk or wait. Wheelchairs may not be available. Going through security can be lengthy and stressful.
- Bus Drop off locations – at times they may be far from entrances.
- Luggage – travelers must be able to physically manage their own luggage.

WHAT TO BRING TO REGISTER:

- 1) **Passport** - so we can make a copy.
- 2) **Checkbook & / or Credit Card** – for payment.
 - a. Travel insurance can only be paid by check.
 - b. A Cruise or Collette tour may be paid for by credit card or check.
 - c. Cruise Checks – make payable to Grand American Tours.
- 3) **Cruise Line Deposit form** or **Registration form** (if you have them).
 - a. One form per person.
 - b. Be sure each person signs at the bottom.

OTHER SUGGESTIONS TO PREPARE WELL:

- **CRUSES:** To find out more about cabin types, look online:
 - Google or search the NAME OF THE CRUISE LINE and enter the NAME OF THE SHIP which is found in the title on the front page of the flyer. They have descriptions of the room types under accommodations. Also, you can look for deck plans. Click on the down arrow to see each deck level.
- **INSURANCE COVERAGE:** Insurance is encouraged.
