



## Winter Weather Road Levels and what they mean for 50 North

When Hancock County is at a **Level 1**,  
50 North will be open as scheduled.

You are welcome to safely attend all activities, but we recommend calling ahead to confirm any classes or presentations led by non-50 North staff. Mobile Meals **will be** delivered and you can request extra and frozen meals by calling 50 North. Chore Services will contact you if they are **not** able to provide their services.

When Hancock County is at a **Level 2**,  
the 50 North building will be open.

All classes, presentations, and special events will be **cancelled**. There will be **no** Mobile Meal delivery, Chore Services, or Outreach Services. The building will be open for lunch, socialization, games, billiards, and the walking track for Fitness members.

---

When Hancock County is at a **Level 3**,  
50 North will be **closed**.

There will be no classes, games, presentations, meals, or services available. The building will be closed.
