North America's National Parks Itinerary:

Day 1: No early wake-up call. Depart late morning for Detroit Metro Airport for late afternoon flight to Calgary, Alberta. Lodging at Calgary Airport tonight. Get ready for a Bucket List Tour called North America's National Parks.

Day 2: At 9:00 am depart for Waterton Lakes National Park.

About Waterton Lakes: There are places on earth that practically defy description-places so unique and beautiful that you can't quite find the words to express what your senses are taking in. Waterton is one of those places. Nestled in the southwest corner of Alberta, Waterton is surrounded by one of the most distinctive mountain ranges on the planet.

Enjoy some leisure time downtown for lunch and check out the shops and boutiques. Late afternoon enjoy a **scenic boat cruise on Water-ton Lake**. Surrounded by the majestic peaks of the **Canadian Rockies**, this is one of America's most scenic cruises. Lodging for (2) nights at the **Bayshore Inn** located right on the **shores of beautiful Waterton Lake**, and in the heart of the village with shops, galleries, pubs and restaurants. **Dinner included.** www.bayshoreinn.com

Day 3: Spend the day exploring Glacier National Park and the Going-to-the-Sun Highway. Set in a rugged section of the Northern Rockies, Glacier Park is an unspoiled domain of alpine scenery, deep valleys, glacier peaks and cascading waterfalls. The Going-to-the-Sun Highway has been described as North America's Most Spectacular Drive. Special Red Jammer vehicles take us along this route. Lunch and dinner included.

Day 4: Today is a travel day to **Yellowstone National Park.** Lodging for (3) nights at the **Holiday Inn West Yellowstone**, a 3-star, full service hotel. Located just two blocks from Yellowstone's West Entrance, the Holiday Inn is the perfect location for our Yellowstone experience. **Dinner is included. www.yellowstonevacations.com**

Day 5: The next (2) days are in depth exploring of Yellowstone National Park. There are many unique places on earth, but perhaps none more unique than Yellowstone National Park, America's first National Park. Begin our Lower Loop Adventure as we visit the main attractions of Yellowstone, including the Fountain Paint Pots, Old Faithful, The Old Faithful Inn, Yellowstone Lakes, The Lake Hotel, Hayden Valley, The Grand Canyon of Yellowstone, Upper Falls, Lower Falls, Crystal Falls and Gibbon Falls. What a day! Lunch included. Our tour ends late afternoon and our hotel is right across from the Grizzly Wolf Discovery Center. Yellowstone is home to more than 200 species of animals, from grizzly bears to bald eagles. Bison, wolves, bears, elk, and nearly 60 other species of mammals roam the park. Other highlights include Mammoth Hot Springs, Tower Falls, Rustic Falls, and Lamar Valley. Now we've seen it all! Lunch is included.

Day 7: Grand Teton National Park features one of the most magnificent ranges in the world! With eight peaks over 12,000 feet, the Tetons are truly memorable. We're on our way to Jackson Hole, Wyoming. Nestled between the Gros Ventre and Teton mountain ranges, Jackson Hole is an authentic, spirted, and distinctive mountain town surrounded by some of America's most breathtaking scenery. Lodging at 49er Inn & Suites. www.townsquare.com. Tonight, join us on a Jackson Lake Dinner Cruise as we get up close and personal with the Teton Mountain Range.

Day 8: Enjoy a leisurely morning and see downtown Jackson by day. Explore the unique downtown and visit the quaint shops. After lunch head to **Salt Lake City** for our last night.
