Sample Itinerary:

Day 1: Among the most spectacular trips in America, this tour has it all. Fly to Denver. Lodging at Hyatt Centric Downtown.

Day 2: Travel to Black Canyon of the Gunnison National Park. Big enough to be overwhelming, yet still intimate enough to feel the pulse of time. On a South Rim guided tour witness some of the steepest cliffs, oldest rock, and craggiest spires in North America. Forces of nature and the Gunnison River sculpted this canyon over two million years. The result is a vertical wilderness of rock, water, and sky. Continue to Grand Junction, CO for (1) night.
